- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of others
- Be fair, considerate and honest in dealing with others
- Accept responsibility for your actions
- Make a commitment to training and performance
- Refrain from any form of abuse, discrimination or harassment towards others verbally, physically or through social media networking.
- Refrain from consuming alcohol and/or illicit drugs
- Be positive roll model
- Respect the coach and abide by their instructions at all times
- Be co-operative and helpful
- Respect the rules and conditions established by the coach and Board
- Follow nutritional guidelines
- Be punctual

Disciplinary Procedure

Where complaints or allegations of misconduct have occurred:

- The Board will investigate the circumstances of any allegation or incident with in the Boards Policy,
- If the swimmer is 18 years of age or under, best endeavors will be made to immediately notify a parent or guardian.
