## Otago U12 Otago Championships - from Simon

Twenty nine swimmers competed at the recent under 12 Otago Champs. Being so close to the end of the year, this meet is always tough for our younger swimmers. As customary however, they brought a lot of guts and smiles to their performances and finishing with a 55% PB rate was a credit to the team. Quilla Cashell-Smith and Shima Jack exemplified that spirit being named along with Erika Fairweather as top swimmers of the Meet.

Erika Fairweather stole the show at the Meet breaking two NZ 12U records in the 800 and 400 Freestyle, along with the Otago 12-13 200IM record. It was testament to Erika's determination after breaking the NZ 800 Free record (by 9 seconds) to follow this up with two further records NZU12 400 Free and Otago 12-13 200IM records.

Congratulations also to Caitlin Hewson and Max Kirkwood who swam qualifying times to elevate them in the C and B squads respectively.

182 swims, 103 PBs (55%). 34 Gold, 22 Silver, 20 Bronze medals won..

#### **Southland Champs 2016 – from Simon**

The sixteen swimmers performed very well with a 62% PB rate including a number of very large P/Bs. (72 P/Bs from 117 races. The team brought home 12 Gold, 15 Silver and 11 Bronse medals with Ella-Rose dominating her age-group. William Christopher showed a great amount of tenacity swimming 20 races producing P/Bs in all but one of his events. Thanks to those hwo came along and helped the team and the meet run smoothly. Top swimmers were William Christophers and Ella-Rose Crooks.

#### **Queensland State Age Group Champs – from Gennadiy**

Eight swimmers competed in 56 races producing 30 (53%) personal best times.

Best performing swimmers of the meet were Oliver Walker who produced four P/Bs from his 4 races reducing 20 seconds from his 200 freestyle, Jessica Scott producing 8 P/Bs from her 10 races and Nicole Heaton producing 5 P/Bs from her 6 races.

**Two Finalists**: Caitlin Deans gained 5<sup>th</sup> in the 400 Free and Nick Pryde 7<sup>th</sup> in the B Final of the 400 Free. Congratulations to all these swimmers. Thank you also to Shirlene Pryde who travelled with the team as Team Manager and caterer.


